FRIENDS OF AMERICAN ART

IN the fifth year book of the Friends of American Art, published in 1916, there is given a complete list, with reproductions, of the purchases of the society during the years 1910-1916, as well as short biographical accounts of the artists represented in the collection and a bibliography. In the present book only the new accessions are reproduced, and only brief lists are given.

Although the activities of the society have necessarily been curtailed by the imperative demands made on subscribers to divert their annual contributions to more urgent needs, some important additions to the collection have been made during the past two years, and a few new names have been added to the list of members. The gift of the Goodman Fund of fifty thousand dollars provides an annual income which when added to the annual revenue of the organization insures its continued purchasing power.

Since the enlargement of the Museum by the opening of the new East Wing, the Art Institute has been able to keep the Friends of American Art collection on exhibition continuously.

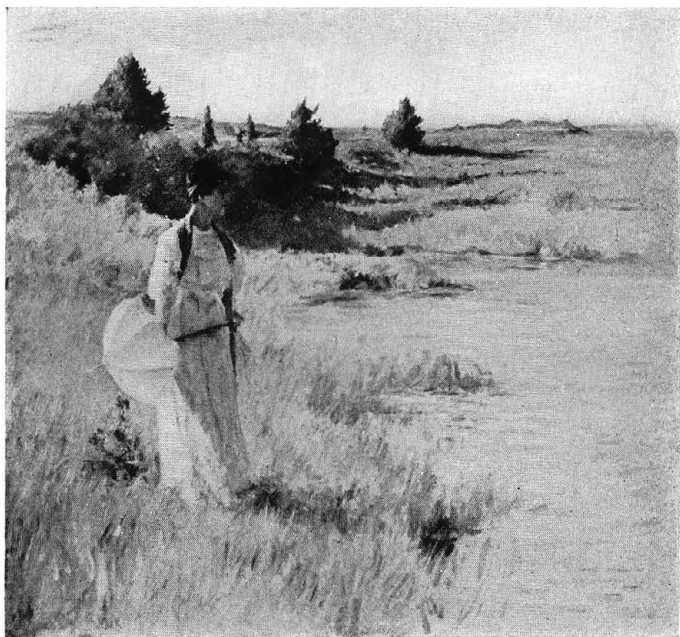

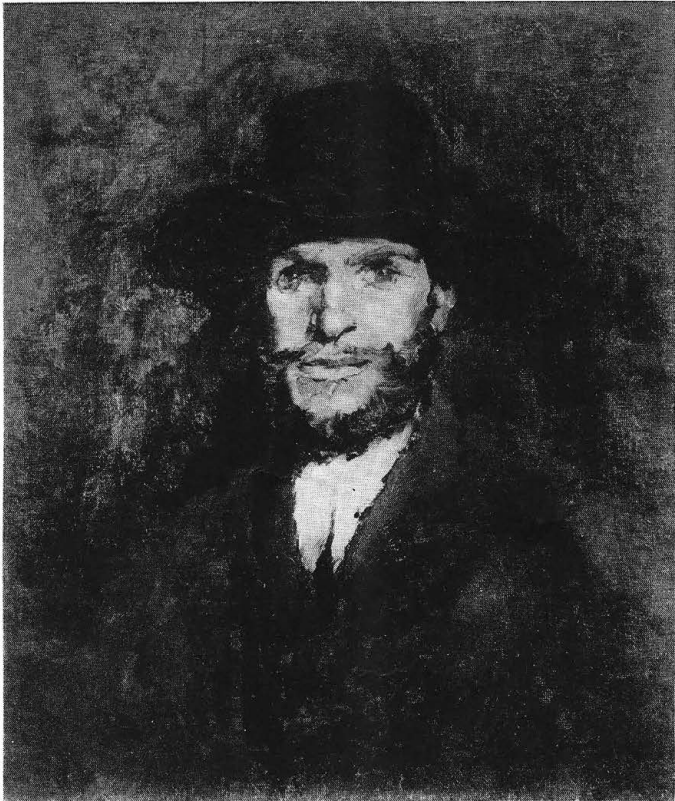

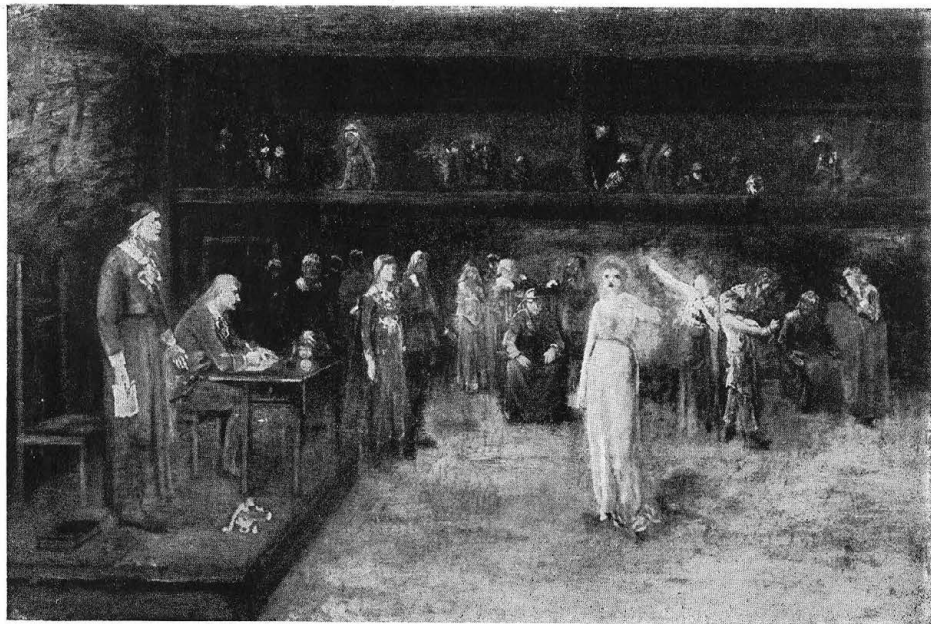

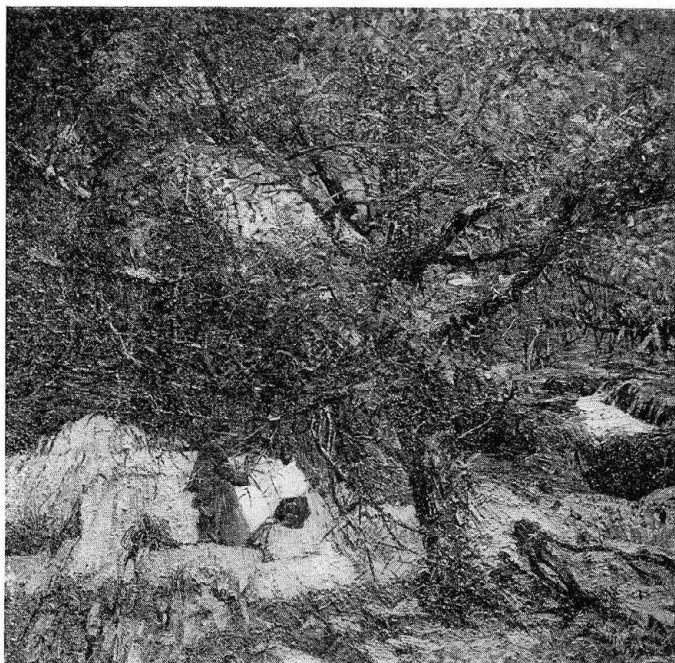

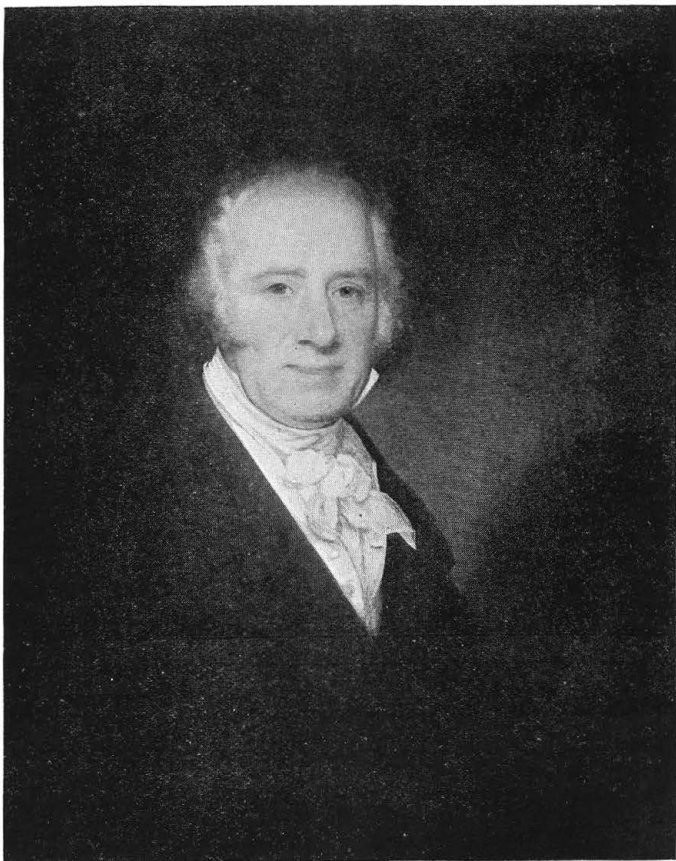

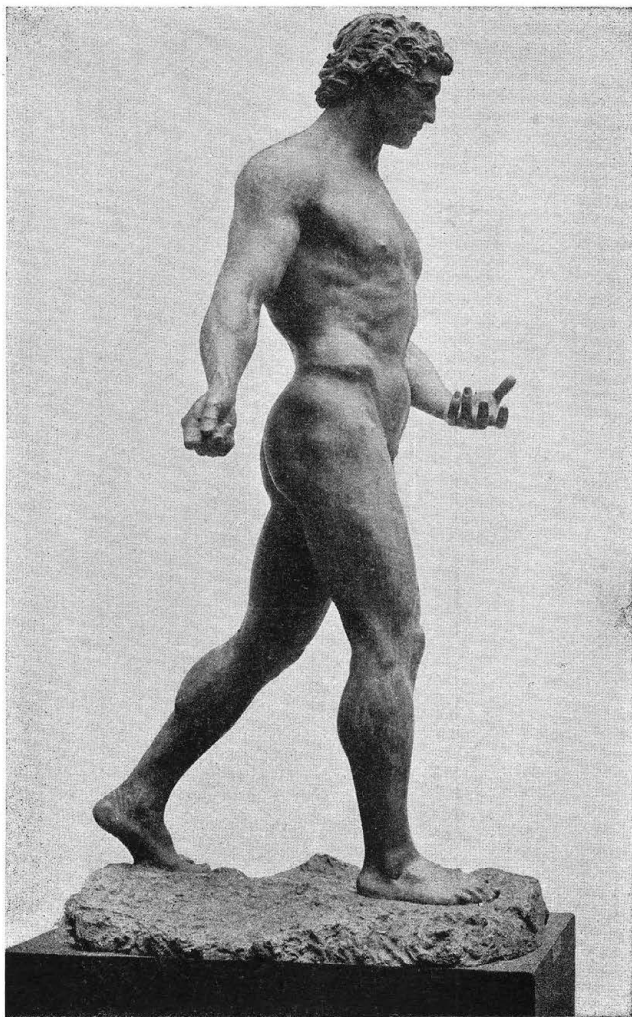

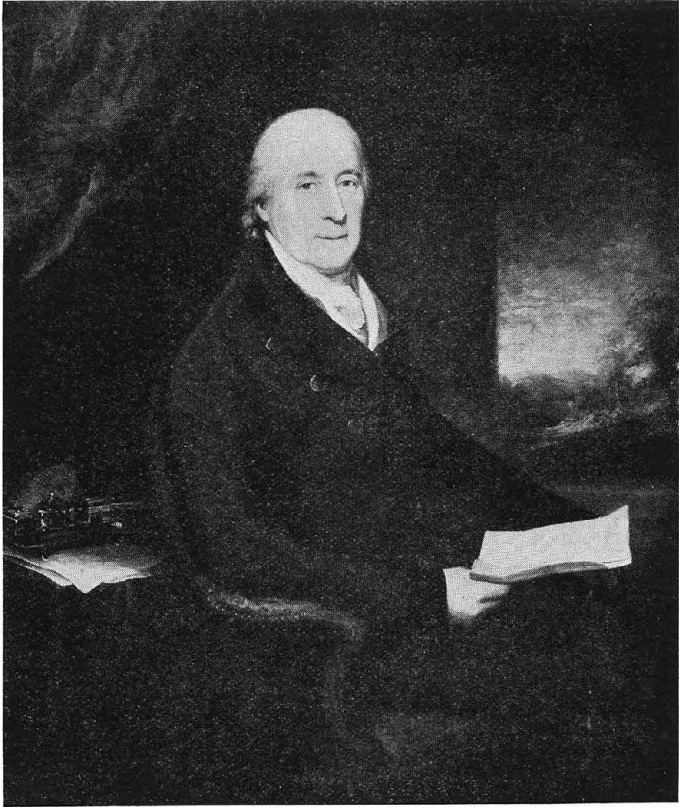
